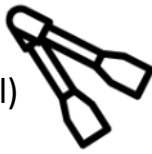
# Simple Steps for Safe SOLO CLEAN-UPS

So, you're looking to make a difference and help clean-up the environment? Here are a few easy steps to stay safe while picking up litter in your neighbourhood and around Junction Creek. Thank you for helping to restore the watershed and community!



## Getting Started

- Check your local Public Health guidelines: visit <https://www.phsd.ca/>
- Make a plan: who will help you, where will you clean, safety concerns, and how will you properly dispose of the garbage? For bag tags, visit <https://garbagetags.greatersudbury.ca/>
- Prepare for Safety: visit the site before the clean-up and read the clean-up [safety tips](#)
- Gather your supplies: garbage bags, gloves (ex. rubber household cleaning gloves or gardening gloves), tongs (recommended), masks, hand sanitizer, and tally sheets (optional)



## On the Day



- Gather your team, making sure to follow current COVID-19 health guidelines
- Dress for the weather, wear closed footwear, and don't forget your clean-up supplies!

## Cleaning Up

- Take pictures! Don't forget to take pictures before, during and after the clean-up to submit later.
- Make note of **what type of litter** you are picking up and the **total number of garbage bags** you fill.

**TIP:** take a photo of all the bags of litter you collected together.



### Stay safe!

Avoid handling hazardous items. Contact the City of Greater Sudbury at 311 to inform them of location of hazardous items such as needles and broken glass.



Pay attention to your surroundings and stay away from the water.

## After Clean-Up

- Properly dispose of the garbage.
- Clean your equipment and wash your hands.
- Give yourself a pat on the back for your success and hard work!
